

Barge 74

Unpowered flat-top barge

Length: 25.0m

Beam: 9.0m

Draft (unladen): 0.32m

Load Capacity: 200 tons

Barge 74 joined the Korevaar fleet in 1997 as the Yellow Barge. After undergoing a colour change the barge acquired a new name in 1999.

This barge has seen service on numerous projects including:

- as a working platform during the refurbishment of an offshore oil rig in Portland, Victoria
- for transporting liquid storage tanks from Melbourne to Geelong
- as a feeding platform, manned by support crews, during the 2007 World Swimming Championships at St Kilda, Port Phillip Bay
- for transporting roof trusses constructed in Geelong for use in the re-development of Southern Cross Station, Melbourne
- as the floating platform on which the stage for the annual Moomba Birdman Rally is constructed
- as a working platform for an excavator during demolition of a wharf on the Maribyrnong River, Melbourne

Barge 74 can be fitted with:

- anchors and winches
- handrails
- spuds for shallow water work
- ladders
